STORAGE CONTAINER "PODS" GUIDELINES

Storage containers are defined as commercially made, portable type containers, which are temporarily placed on a lot.

- 1. The storage container shall be of commercial construction. No homemade containers are allowed.
- 2. The storage container by the trade name "POD" shall be a typical example of a commercial style container.
- 3. The owner shall submit an application to the Property Manager specifying the date that the container will be delivered and the date the container will be removed. The owner shall wait for written approval before placing the container upon his property. The maximum time for storage of the container on the property is three (3) days. Any additional time shall be approved in writing by the Property Manager.
- 4. The container shall be placed on the driveway, directly in front of the overhead garage door and shall not block the sidewalk.
